

TRI-CITY HIGH SCHOOL HONORS ILLINOIS STATE SCHOLARS

BUFFALO, IL – Tri-City High School Principal Duane Schupp is pleased to announce that four Tri-City High School seniors have been recognized as 2010 Illinois State Scholars: Griffin Brunson, Matt Justice and Skylar Morris of Dawson, and Kim Garner of Mechanicsburg.



The prestigious award is given annually by the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) which is recognizing 18,178 high school students from across the state as this year's State Scholars. Illinois State Scholar winners rank in the top ten percent of the state's high school seniors from 711 high schools in all 102 counties. Selection is based on SAT, ACT and/or Prairie State Achievement Exam scores, and/or class rank at the end of the junior year.

"These students personify excellence," said ISAC Executive Director Andrew Davis, whose agency has overseen the Illinois State Scholars program since 1958. "Illinois State Scholars are among the best and the brightest in our state's high schools.
