

Homework Policy Modification

Dear Families,

As the weather changes from cold and dreary into warm and sunny, students are inclined to get “spring fever” the last quarter of the school year, and homework completion tends to drop when the weather is nice outside. As an incentive to staying on top of getting assignments completed on time, our class will have a revised homework policy the last nine weeks of the school year.

The homework policy will remain the same as it has all year with a slight modification. Students will now keep track of their late or incomplete assignments on a chart. Each time they have a late or incomplete assignment, they must fill out their individual homework chart, date it, and have it signed by a guardian. Once a student reaches a total of **10 missing or late assignments**, they will **NOT** be permitted to attend the 5th grade class field trip to the St. Louis Science Center in May nor participate in “Play Day” towards the end of school. If a student is close to their limit, a phone call home to a parent or guardian will be made as a reminder.
